- Be employed in a school within the Children’s Reading Foundation of the Mid-Columbia’s service area (all of Benton and Franklin Counties plus the Columbia School District).

If you meet *all* the above requirements please sign-up for the First Teacher Library program. Simply complete and return the form below and we will deliver your 75 book library to your school in September or beginning of October. First Teacher Library requests submitted no later than or by September 20th will be delivered to your school in September or October.
